

Fieldstone Homeowners' Association Pool Rules

- **No solo swimming.** We encourage residents to only swim when others are present for safety reasons.
- **No hard toys** including footballs (nerf included), soccer balls, tennis balls, water guns and balloons.
- **No running or rough play.**
- **No diving** – the water is too shallow.
- While alcohol is permitted, **no alcohol abuse or drugs are permitted** in the pool or pool area.
- **No spitting or blowing nose in the pool.**
- **NO SMOKING WHILE IN THE POOL.**
- **No persons with communicable diseases** are permitted in the pool.
- **No persons with skin, eye, ear or nasal infections** are allowed in the pool.
- Any person who is incontinent or not fully potty-trained must **wear appropriate waterproof clothing** (e.g., swim diapers, etc.) when entering or being carried into the pool. No person with diarrhea is permitted to enter the pool. Diapers may not be changed in the pool area except fully within the restroom facilities.
- **No inappropriate behavior in bathrooms.**
- **No inappropriate behavior** (including foul language, yelling, fighting etc.).
- **No skateboards, bicycles or scooters** allowed in pool area.
- Any toys or personal items left in the pool area will be placed in the trash at closing.
- **No animals or pets** allowed in the pool or on the pool deck.
- **No glass** allowed in the pool or on the pool deck.
- No individual, regardless of age, may use the pool unless they are either (1) a strong and competent swimmer, or (2) are under the direct and constant supervision of a strong and competent swimmer. Minors that are not strong swimmers must have appropriate floatation appearal.
- Showers must be taken before entering the pool.
- Bathroom facilities are available to all homeowners and their guests, please keep the restrooms clean.
- Pool hours are from 8 a.m. until 8 p.m. (or sunset whichever occurs first) daily.
- The maximum number of people allowed in the pool area is one hundred twenty (120).
- Emergency first aid kit is located inside the pool area.
- Homeowners (HOA members) are responsible and liable for their guests.
- Owners are allowed 4 guests per household. Guests must be accompanied by a Fieldstone resident at all times.
- No lifeguard will be on duty – **SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.**
- **No grills or grilling** at the pool.

Any homeowners in violation of these rules will have their pool privileges suspended at the Board's discretion. Continuous failure to comply after warnings can/will result in suspension for one (1) pool season without reimbursement of Association dues.
