Springfield Tennis Rules and Regulations

These rules exist for the purpose of maintaining our courts and providing an opportunity for all to use them. Please be considerate of others so that the courts may be enjoyed by all authorized players. Please use your unique access code for access to the amenity center restrooms.

- No outside instructors or coaching allowed. All lessons, clinics, leagues, etc., must be scheduled with an approved Springfield Tennis Professional. See the names and phone numbers of the instructors on the tennis info page.
- A 1:1 ratio of homeowner to non-resident for singles and 1:3 ratio for doubles play must be maintained.
- All Leagues schedules will be planned, and courts will be reserved accordingly.
- All Clinics will be planned with the Tennis Pro, and courts reserved accordingly. If you are scheduling a private or semi-private lesson with the one of the Pros it is the homeowner's responsibility to reserve a court for the lesson- not the Pro.
- For walk on court use, please remember to check the Springfield POA reservation calendar prior to using a court.
- Reservations **must** be made through the Springfield POA website (see the reservations tab on the website).
- Please be courteous to other players by arriving and exiting the court on time. If the homeowner is not on court within 15 mins of reservation time, then the reservation will be forfeited to persons waiting.
- Reservations are limited to a 2-hour session and a maximum of 2 weeks advance booking with the exception of the league play – Captains only can schedule home match court reservations for the entire season by contacting the Community Manager.
- Per the Facilities Use Agreement, children under the age of 12 are not permitted on the courts without a parent or legal guardian present.
- Sneakers or tennis shoes, and appropriate tennis attire must be worn on tennis courts. Shirts must be worn at all times, and bathing suits are not permitted. No bare feet or flip flops.
- No wheeled vehicles of any type are allowed on the courts. This includes but is not limited to bicycles, roller skates, electric cars, remote-controlled cars and skateboards. However, tennis ball machines are permitted.
- No ball playing of any kind other than tennis is permitted.
- Tennis ball cans and other debris should be placed in trash receptacles.
- No food, alcoholic beverages or glass allowed on the courts.
- No dog walking or pets are allowed on the tennis courts.
- The use of foul language or throwing of racquets is permitted.
- Smoking is not permitted on the tennis courts.
